Meeting Summary:

Dr. Juli Passarelli opened the meeting with announcements regarding upcoming events and SCAITE business.

1. Upcoming meetings:

2. Miller and Lea revision:

Two weeks ago, final edited keys were sent to their respective authors for a final review. Majority of the authors have replied back though there are a few stragglers. Today, SCAITE conducted their final review of the book in its entirety. Juli and Milton will meet on July 1st and 2nd for their final review. The book is tentatively scheduled to go to print at the end of July. Selected printing companies have been asked to submit price quotes. Publication is anticipated by the end of 2019. An Early Release party will be held at Cabrillo Marine Aquarium likely in November. Details are still being worked out.

The question arose on whether the current book revision is to be considered a second edition or a third edition. The discussion is focused around the 1976 reprint when an addendum of 13 pages was added. With the addition of the addendum, is that book considered a revised reprint or a second edition to the original 1972 book? SCAITE members were not able to definitively answer that question. Juli will contact some professionals in the field such as librarians and/or publishers whom may have insight on how to resolve the edition issue.
